There were 3 members of the public attended the meeting.

There were two points raised, one being litter in and around the Parish and also lack of communication.

It has been noticed that there is a lot more litter especially on Braystones Beach and Lantern Moss area, and recently litter on the new coastal path.

Clerk had been in touch with the Probation Service to see if this is something they can sort out, unfortunately due to Covid they are not doing this service but to ring back in the Autumn to see where things stand.

It was mentioned that the Rotary Club were to organise a litter pick for the South side of Braystones beach at Lantern Moss, they were informed that they would be able to

borrow litter pickers and black bin bags, inform the Parish Council, when and where the bags of rubbish would be and these could then be collected by Copeland Council. Some flyers would be given to the Clerk for display for the noticeboards and the website saying a time and date for the litter pick.

The other point is communication between the Parish Council and Parishioners was seemed to be lacking, but as two of the noticeboards, one in Nethertown (which is being made at present) and one at Coulderton again needs mended. Clerk did say that there was a facebook page and this was started early 2020, the Lowside Quarter Parish Council Website had just become live and this was still a work in progress, things would be added in time.

Although the last year we have not had any face to face meetings or any events that could be advertised.

It was also mentioned that maybe a short piece about any upcoming events, (after ALL restrictions are lifted) in the St Bees Church Magazine, Clerk to look into this.

Meeting ended 6.30 pm
