Nethertown have been "gifted" a defib unit by William Morley, in honour of his son Billy, Cllr Lang is on with seeing where this can be properly sited. William has also said he will arrange training to be able to use it for anybody who would like to know.

Cllr Lang is also trying to gain more funding for more defib units and is in talks with the ambulance service for how many and where they would need put, Nethertown should have 2 by all accounts.

Noticeboards are in need of attention, these will be sorted hopefully in August.
