

# Chair's Annual Report 2026

- Successful installation of 7 defibrillators around the Parish working with NWS after receiving funding from the GDF community fund
- CPR and defibrillator awareness sessions delivered by NWS carried out with full attendance
- Following collision on Braystones level crossing a meeting was organised between Network Rail and local residents to discuss additional safety measures
- Letter of support for a structural engineering survey on Braystones beach front for application to the GDF community fund
- Funding secured for litter picking equipment, used at monthly beach cleans and available for Parish use
- Investigated possibility of fire hydrant on Coulderton beach front, unfortunately small bore pipeline would not support provision
- Resilience planning ongoing - a conference attended, initial meeting held locally, Community Emergency Hub resource kit acquired, Resilience Plan currently being drafted, communication within the Parish expanding
- Copies of Sellafield "Emergency Action Card" now displayed in noticeboards around the Parish
- Dangerous barn roofs in Nethertown made safe
- Broken fence behind Nethertown station fixed by Network Rail
- Website made Assertion 10 compliant to fall in line with new Government regulations and standards, remaining issues to be addressed by October 2026
- New .gov.uk email address and website, transition to Government standard template for the website in progress
- Online banking established
- Ongoing dialogue with Council re. flooding on Nethertown road, street nameplate for Hemplin Gardens, new road sign needed at Snellings Road end
